NOTICE IS GIVEN TO DEFENDANT THAT:


It has been alleged that you have violated the terms of usage of your ignition interlock Device (IID) with regard to your license suspension in this case. It is alleged that you have violated the terms of your IID by:

- _____ operating a vehicle not equipped with an IID
- _____ operating the IID vehicle beyond the scope of your privileges
- _____ tampering with the IID device
- operating the IID vehicle with a positive alcohol reading preventing the vehicle from starting

IF THE ALLEGED VIOLATION IS TRUE, YOU WILL FACE ADDITIONAL SANCTIONS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO INCREASING THE LENGTH OF YOUR LICENSE SUSPENSION, OR BEING REQUIRED TO WEAR A CONTINUOUS ALCOHOL MONITORING DEVICE. YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO APPEAL THIS SANCTION IF YOU DISPUTE THE ALLEGED VIOLATION. AN APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITHIN FOURTEEN (14) DAYS OF THIS NOTICE, BY FILING AN APPEAL AND REQUEST FOR HEARING IN WRITING WITH THE COURT IN THIS CASE. THE JUDGE MAY GRANT A HEARING TO HEAR YOUR APPEAL. IF YOU DO NOT FILE AN APPEAL, YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THE ADDITIONAL SANCTION WHICH WILL BE IMPOSED.
